To receive UHJA approval for a show, this application/contract must be completed, signed and returned, with a \$50 deposit, to the UHJA Horse Show Chairman or Secretary. This must be received before a date will be reserved for a show.

Upon receipt of this application/contract, the members of the UHJA Horse show Committee will be notified. The show dates will be approved unless a concern is brought up by one of the committee members (about either the show itself or the facility at which the show is being held). In this case, a meeting of the UHJA Horse Show Committee and Board of Directors will be called to take an actual vote on the approval of the show. The management of the horse show will be notified of the meeting and asked to attend.

The current UHJA mailing list will be sent to the show manager upon approval of the prize list. Proposed prize lists need to be submitted for approval at least six weeks prior to the show.

To receive approval for a show from the UHJA, a show's management must agree to the following:

1. They will follow all rules and specifications found in the current copy of the UHJA Rule Book and the rules of the USEF where they are not covered by the UHJA Rule Book.
2. They will honor all suspensions imposed by the UHJA Board of Directors and the USEF.
3. They will mail a copy of the premium list to all current UHJA members at least three weeks before the closing date for entries to their show.
4. They will submit show results, new memberships, and payment for the Callister Cup Classic to the UHJA Horse Show Committee Secretary within two weeks following the close of the show. These results must include: the class name, number of entries in the class and the results of the class, through sixth place or reserve, if given, showing the names of the horse, rider and owner. \*\*There will be a \$5 per day fine imposed if the above is not timely.
5. Enclose a \$50 show deposit with the signed application/contract. This deposit will be returned if the show has complied with all rules and specifications for show approval.
5. Shows will be charged a \$5 per day fine for not sending in results, new memberships, and Callister Cup Classic fees within two weeks following the end of the show. You may send electronic results to: narm@centalpets.com. Mail other information to Nancy Armantrout, 1458 Clayton St., SLC UT 84104. Failure to comply with the regulations for having a UHJA approved show may result in forfeiture of the show deposit, a probationary period, suspension, or other penalties that may be decided by the UHJA Board of Directors.

**3' LOW HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to all horses and riders not restricted by showing in previous divisions.

### NEW CLASS

**UHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL 3'6":** Open to junior and amateur riders. To be judged 50% on flat work and 50% on over fence round. There must be 3 riders to hold this class.

### NEW CLASS

**2'6" JUMPER:** A horse/rider combination showing in this class cannot have shown over fences over 2'9" in height.
